Utah State Library Division Awards Utah Libraries Grant Dollars

The (USL) Utah State Library has announced that 11 Utah libraries were awarded \$125,068 in (IMLS) Institute of Museum and Library Services through (LSTA) Library Service and Technology Act grant dollars administered through USL to enhance library services.

“LSTA funds are intended to help libraries develop their central roles as community builders and used to promote improvements in services to all types of libraries,” says State Librarian Colleen Eggett. “This latest round of grants is divided among school, public and academic libraries to help support a wide array of projects from children’s programs to providing updated technology.”
