

The 2020 General Election is just weeks away! Utah County is participating in a pilot program for all county residents with disabilities and their caretakers. Any type of disability including but not limited to, any impairment, physical limitation or medical condition qualifies for this program. This program gives the same opportunity to vote electronically that active military and overseas civilians currently have.

All that is needed to receive an electronic ballot is to complete a Disabled Voter Application and submit it to the Utah County Elections Office **before October 23, 2020**.

You can access an application:

Voting electronically allows voters to use their own accessibility devices and maintain social distancing during the COVID19 pandemic.

Electronic ballots can be received and voted one of two ways:

- Mobile voting application:
 - The voter downloads and installs the app (available for Android and Apple devices)
 - Set up your account and verify your identity
 - A ballot will be sent to your smart device
 - Vote your ballot, sign the voter affidavit and submit your ballot
- Email:
 - We will email a ballot, affidavit and privacy waiver form
 - Print and vote the ballot
 - Print and sign the affidavit and privacy waiver
 - Scan and email the completed ballot and forms to the election office
